

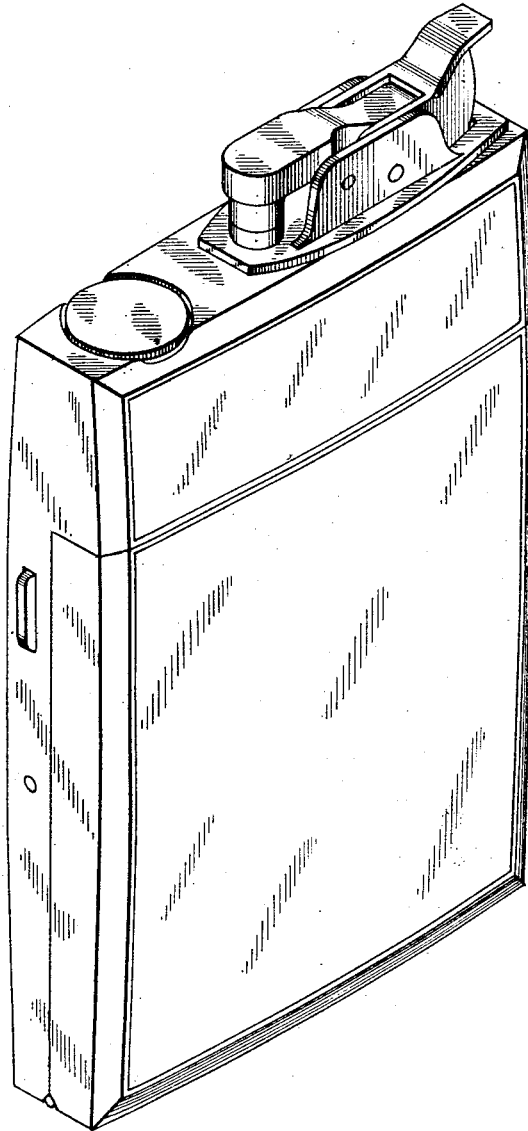

DESIGN FOR A COMBINATION POCKET LIGHTER AND CIGARETTE HOLDER

Application filed October 19, 1929. Serial No. 33,101. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CECIL HARRY LAWRENCE, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Attleboro, in the county of Bristol and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combination Pocket Lighter and Cigarette Holder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
