

DESIGN FOR A COMBINED CIGARETTE CONTAINER AND PYROPHORIC LIGHTER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Frederick A. Whittaker, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Attleboro, in the county of Bristol and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a.Combined Cigarette Container and Pyrophoric Lighter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a cigarette container and lighter embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front view thereof;

Fig. 3 is a back view thereof; and

Figs. 4 and 5 are side views thereof viewed respectively from the left and right of Fig. 2.

The dominant features of my new design are the squared-off corners at the upper end of the case and the provision of a thumbpiece having substantially square corners, corresponding to those of the case.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combined cigarette container and pyrophoric lighter as shown and described.
