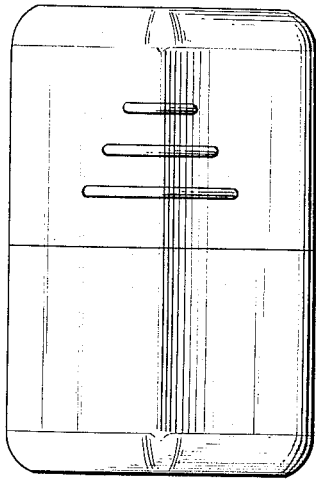

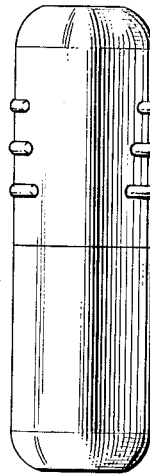

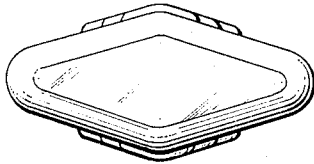

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Hans Silberknopf, a citizen of Austria and a resident of Vienna, Austria, whose post-office address is 50 Seitenberggasse, Vienna XVI, Austria, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Casing for Pyrophoric Lighters of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
