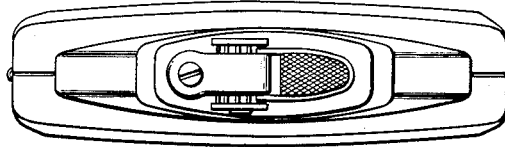

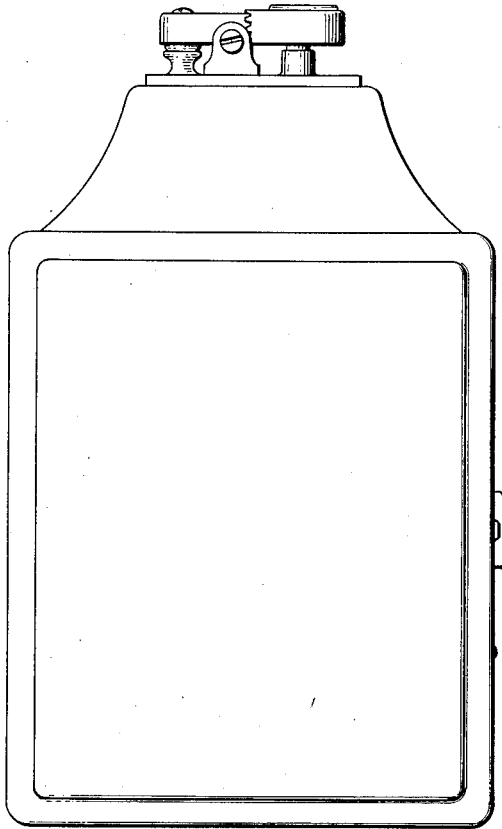

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Louis V. Aronson, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newark, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Pyrophoric Lighter and Cigarette Container, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof wherein:

Figure 1 is a plan view of a combined pyro-

phoric lighter and cigarette container showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; and

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view thereof.
