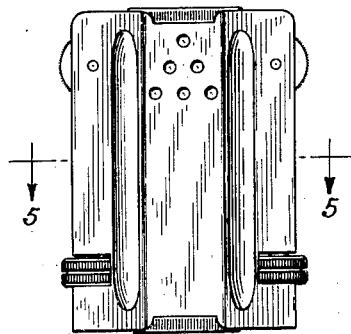

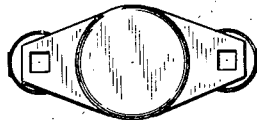

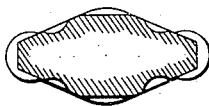

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edward W. Rector, a citizen of the United States, residing at Melrose Park, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cigar and Cigarette Lighter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of the cigar and cigarette lighter embodying my new design.

Fig. 2 is a face view.

Fig. 3 is a bottom view.

Fig. 4 is a side view.

Fig. 5 is a cross section taken on line 5—5 of Fig. 7.
