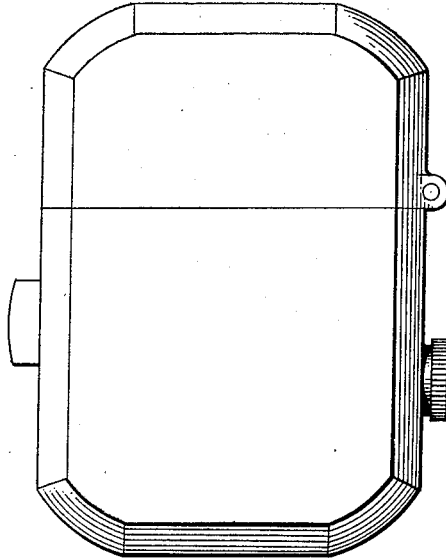

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, FREDERICK W. GOERDES, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of East Orange, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Cases for Pocket-Igniters, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevation of a pocket igniter showing my new design, and Fig. 2 is an edge view of the same.
