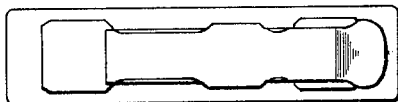

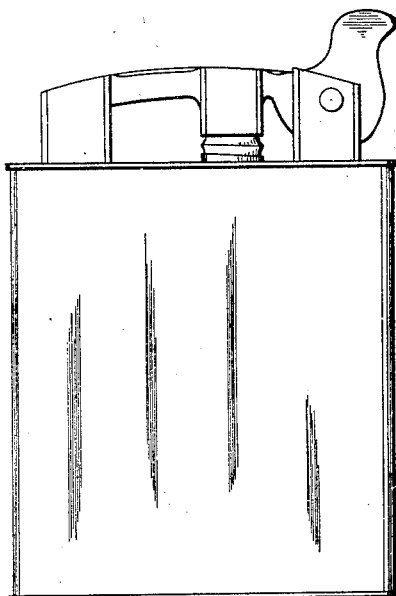

DESIGN FOR A CIGAR LIGHTER.

Application filed June 18, 1928. Serial No. 27,175. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:
