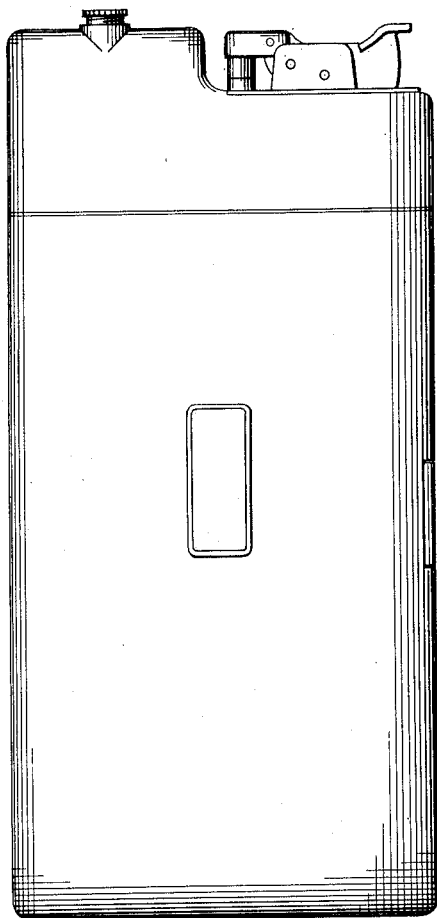

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED F. REILLY, a citizen of the United States, residing at North Attleboro, county of Bristol, and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Cigarette Case and Lighter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front view of a combined cigarette case and lighter showing my new design; Fig. 2 is a side view of the same.
