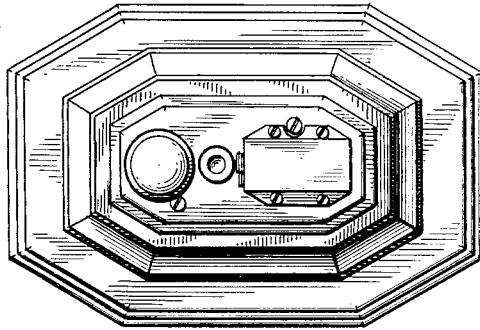

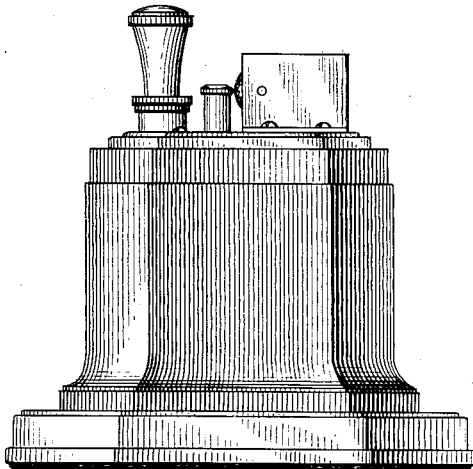

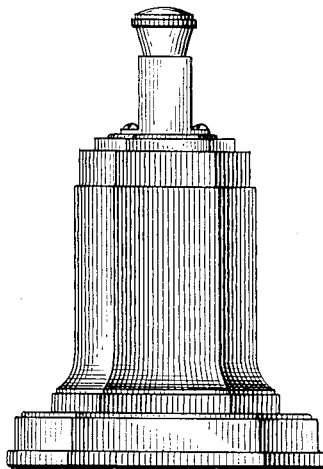

## DESIGN FOR A PYROPHORIC LIGHTER

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Louis V. Aronson, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newark, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pyrophoric Lighter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof wherein:

Figure 1 is a plan view of the pyrophoric lighter showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front elevational view of the pyrophoric lighter; and

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view of said pyrophoric lighter.
